

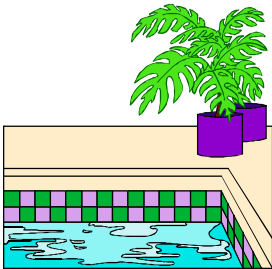
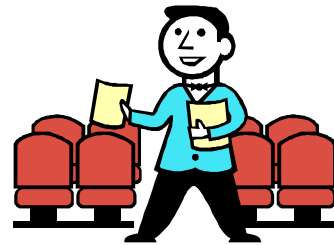
Money Word Problems

1. I have £76 to spend on Christmas presents. If I find an item costing £17.65, how many can I buy? How much change will I have?

2. It costs £4.60 for adults to go to the cinema and £3.80 for children. How many children did 4 adults take if they spent £27?



3. Each month I try to treat myself to a visit to the health spa. If I save £106 and each visit costs £8.70, will I be able to go every month? If not, how many months can I go?

4. Sophie tries to buy a CD every week out of her £15 pocket money and they cost £12.95. She has not bought one for a while and has 6 weeks pocket money saved up. However, she spent £8.98 on a birthday present for her brother. How many CDs can she buy when she goes shopping?
